TTR has won European funding for a project to improve the quality of life by transferring innovation in the field of planning and urban mobility from the research community to end users in the cities of Europe. PLUME (Planning Urban Mobility in Europe) is a Thematic Network funded by the European Commission's DG Research which builds on the work of the Land Use and Transport Research cluster in the City of Tomorrow Programme. As well as co-ordinating the project, TTR has particular responsibility for identifying the research needs of end-user cities, establishing an approach to benchmarking in the field of land-use and mobility planning, and overall network management. The project started on 1st November 2002 and will run until April 2005.
